In 2020 the parish council began work with Toni from Charitytrusts.co.uk to consolidate the various dormant charities into one village charity. The following steps were taken:

Trustees updated to Suzanne Royston, Nick Bennett and Paul Fishpool

All funds held in various bank accounts with Lloyds and Barclays transferred to the Gift of Delamere and Francis (GDF) account (to be renamed the Chippenham Charity Account).

Toni to carry out the necessary work with the Charity Commission to close the charity accounts.

Units held for various charities with CCLA were transferred to the GDF account.

The Tharps Charity is shared with Snailwell. The trustees worked with their parish council to identify suitable recipients for the funds (as the money could not be given to the parish council). In January 2021 Snailwell received their share in full and final settlement. This money was shared between the Bridge of Hope charity (£1076.22) and George and Dragon public house (£500) to provide £10 vouchers towards meals for residents, especially those in hardship.
